**Town Of Owasa**  
Minutes of Regular Meeting  
Jackson Township Hall

Mayor James Nehring called the regular meeting of the Owasa Town Council to order.

Present were council members: Jim Carpenter, Dave Cellan, Paul Hazelwood, Jerry June and Jill Trauger.

Also present: Hardin County Engineer, Taylor Roll. Also present was Ashton June.

Taylor Roll gave a presentation regarding the Funding Agreement between the Iowa DOT and the City of Owasa and Hardin County to fund the replacement of the bridge on Hwy D-35. The agreement provides 100% of the funding and is scheduled for 2024 taking probably 4 – 5 months. A Resolution to approve the signing of the funding agreement (1-22-HBP-010) was presented. A motion to approve the resolution and sign the agreement was made by Jerry June and seconded by Dave Cellan. All voted in favor and the motion was carried and the agreement was signed.

The minutes of the previous meeting were called for and read. A motion was made by Dave Cellan and seconded by Jill Trauger to accept the minutes as read. All voted in favor and the motion was carried.
